New MID Payment Gateway and IWA IBG Integration

Introduction

The purpose of this document is to guide the user through the new payment options on the MID and the new integrated IWA IBG (Insurance Backed Guarantee) product range offer. It includes a step-by-step guide on how to navigate the new sections in the certificate creation process.

You will need access to the MCS Installations Database as an MCS contractor.


1. MID Payment Gateway and IBG overview

The latest MID (MCS Installations Database) development includes a new payment gateway in the MID, in conjunction with the launch of an Insurance Backed Guarantee (IBG) product range, provided by IWA. The MCS-IWA Insurance Backed Guarantee offer will be available for all MCS technologies, except for Micro CHP and Wind technologies.

The transition to a new and easier payment gateway in the MID will be much simpler for MCS contractors to navigate when creating certificates. The remainder of the document will highlight that MCS has moved away from the use of credits, however, the PayPal portal will still be used. The new MID-PayPal integration allows a 'pay as you go' payment method, either via debit or credit card or by using an existing/new PayPal account. An installer 'basket' has also been introduced, to accommodate contractors who prefer to purchase MID products (e.g., certificates, IBGs') in bulk.

2. Certificate Creation Process

The process on how to create an MCS certificate has altered slightly, due to the new payment methods and the integration of new options associated with the IWA IBG offer. Step one of the certificate creation will now ask whether an installation is domestic or commercial, the technology type of the installation, as well as the overall cost of the system (including VAT). Contractors must ensure that these details are inputted correctly.



There is also the option to input the customer's email address if the contractor would like the certificate to be automatically sent to the relevant customer. If the contractor would prefer to provide the certificate to the customer directly, this field can be bypassed. An optional 'Installer Project Reference Number' field has also been added to this stage of the certificate, to allow installers to specify a project number that is associated with the installation.

Once these fields have been completed, select 'next' and a confirmation box will appear, asking for confirmation that the information that has been inputted is correct. As explained below, these details will not be able to be amended later when the certificate has been generated, unless the contractor contacts the MCS helpdesk.

	Before progressing to generate the MCS certificate, please confirm that you have correctly selected that the installation is for either a domestic or a commercial property and that you have correctly input the total cost of the installation (this is the full amount that has been invoiced and includes VAT). You will not be able to edit this information once this certificate has been created.

3. MID Purchase Items

As MCS is now offering optional extras to MCS contractors, specifically an IBG product range provided by IWA, the certificate creation process has altered. These IBGs for installations will be available for purchase at the point of certificate creation, this will simplify the process for MCS contractors.

The range of IBGs with different cover periods and premiums is displayed in the drop-down menu in the options column. The MCS contractor can choose which IBG product they would like to purchase, by selecting the tick box and selecting an IBG from the menu. This IBG will be purchased at the same time as the MCS certificate and the total will be added to the price column.

More details of the IBGs offered by IWA can be found in the table below:

Policy Payment Structure - Domestic Contracts only

Solar PV – contract values up to £25,000	
Two-year IBG insurance	£15 per contract
Five-year IBG insurance	£30 per contract
Solar PV – contract values up to £15,000	
Seven-year IBG insurance	£90 per contract
Ten-year IBG insurance	£90 per contract

Heat Pumps contract values up to £50,000	
Two-year IBG insurance	£20 per contract
Five-year IBG insurance	£40 per contract

Solar Thermal – contract values up to £25,000	
Two-year IBG insurance	£15 per contract
Five-year IBG insurance	£30 per contract


Battery Storage – contract values up to 25,000	
Two-year IBG insurance	£15 per contract
Five-year IBG insurance	£30 per contract

Biomass – contract values up to £50,000	
Two-year IBG insurance	£50 per contract
Five-year IBG insurance	£80 per contract

For commercial contracts, two-year and five-year insurance-backed guarantees are available for all products, with the IBG price equating to 1% of the total contract value.

Sourcing an IBG from IWA via the MID is not mandatory, so MCS-certified contractors are permitted to obtain IBGs from alternative IBG providers in the market (e.g. CPA, QANW). If an MCS-certified contractor chooses to do this, they are required to complete the below declaration, to confirm that they will obtain an IBG from another provider (unless it is a commercial installation). The requirement for MCS-certified Contractors to provide consumers with an Insurance Backed Guarantee, is stipulated by the contractor's Consumer Code, so this requirement must be adhered to.





When the contractor reaches the 'Insurance Backed Guarantee Policy Owner' section, this page will request the system owner's name and email address. These details will not appear on the MCS certificate itself, but rather this information will be held in a report that will be sent to IWA regularly. The information is required so that IWA is aware of who to send the IBG policy documentation.

Note: this page will only appear if an IWA IBG has been selected by the contractor, through the MID. If an IWA IBG has not been purchased via the MID, the contractor will need to specify the alternative IBG provider.

4. Payment

At the beginning of the certificate creation (step 2), the MCS contractor will still have the option to use any existing credits on their MID account, before they completely move to the pay-as-you-go/basket purchase method. If a contractor chooses to use an existing credit, the price of the certificate will be listed as 'free'. If the contractor chooses to use the new payment methods (not using credits), the price of the certificate will default to £30 (excluding VAT) (please see below).

When the MCS contractor reaches the final stage in creating their MCS certificate, the below page will show a breakdown of the certificate and IBG costs (if applicable). Two cost totals will be listed, a total including VAT and a total excluding VAT.

To process the payment, the contractor will have two options to choose from:

- 1) Select 'Pay with PayPal' to pay for the certificate/IBG immediately, OR
- 2) Add the certificate/IBG to the basket, to be purchased at a later time, perhaps with other certificates






4.1. Pay As You Go Option

If the contractor would like to pay for the certificate immediately, the contractor will need to select 'Pay with PayPal' (see below). This will redirect the contractor to the PayPal portal in which they can either log in to their own PayPal account to pay from a PayPal balance or can pay with a debit/credit card.








Once the payment has been processed via PayPal, the contractor will be redirected back to the MID and a box will appear stating 'confirm and make payment'. By clicking this, the contractor is confirming that the payment is complete and that the amount has been charged to their chosen card.




Upon selecting the 'confirm and make payment' button, the certificate will be available to download and a copy should be sent to the system owner (if the contractor has not requested the MID send the certificate automatically).



Note: Payment receipts for the MID purchases will be sent to the email listed on the contractor's MID account. This receipt will include a breakdown of the products purchased, and a VAT breakdown and will also contain the relevant VAT registration number.

4.2. Using the Installer Basket

If the contractor would prefer to pay for the certificate and IBG (if applicable), later or with other MCS certificates, the contractor can select 'add to basket' to add the MID products to the installer basket.



The MID will then direct the contractor to the 'Basket for installer' area (see below):

The basket will now list the technology type of the certificate added, the date and time the certificate was created, along with the address details and the total spend. The certificate will remain in the basket until the contractor selects 'Purchase selected'.

Note: the status of the certificate will remain as 'in basket' and will not be officially generated until the payment has been made.

Contractors are also able to add several other certificates to the basket if they would like to pay for several certificates in one transaction (example below):

Once 'purchase selected has been selected, the below screen will appear, providing a breakdown of the MID purchases. To complete the payment, the contractor must select 'Pay with PayPal'. This will direct the contractor to the PayPal portal, in which they can either log in to their own PayPal account to pay from a PayPal balance or can pay with a debit/credit card.
